This December, Ottawa Public Health will continue to offer H1N1 vaccine clinics. As part of its ongoing effort to reach all Ottawa residents, the following neighbourhood clinics will be offered to all members of the local community at the following locations:

Please note that a parent or legal guardian must accompany children under 14.

In an effort to minimize line-ups, wristbands will be given out at all clinics beginning at 9 a.m. on weekdays and 7:30 a.m. on weekends (this applies only to École secondaire catholique Franco-Cité and Fisher Park Elementary School). Once you receive one or more wristbands for you and your family, you will be given an estimated time (if necessary) to return to the clinic – avoiding a long wait time.
